Agenda Items

Agenda Topic 1:

Introducing new Middle School Principal

- Mrs. Gadsden introduced PAVE's incoming Middle School Principal Brenda Smith.
- Ms. Smith provided a brief overview of her experience.

Agenda Topic 2

State Exam Updates:

 Principals provided a brief overview of NYSE testing coordination and culture at PAVE this year. Their general outlook was positive. PAVE expects to receive scores by Aug 2023.

Agenda Topic 3

Budget Review

- Mrs. Gadsden started the budget review with stating the programmatic vision for the next school year. She
 shared that her long-term goal is to provide a premier educational experience for students at PAVE Academy
 Charter School. While in the short term we continue to recover from the pandemic, and take steps towards our
 reimagination.
- Mrs. Gadsden also shared updates to PAVE's planned staffing model.
- Mrs. Forbes highlighted and reviewed the following:
 - Programmatic investments being made in the proposed SY 2023-2024 budget which includes targeting tutoring and after-school programing.
 - Enrollment projections for SY 2023 2024 of 460 students.

- PAVE will continue to run operating deficits in the short-term, we will look to the operating cash account as our first line of defense. Over the next two years, PAVE's Leadership Team along with The Board of Directors will develop a sustainable program and/or work to increase revenue via development efforts.
- Mrs. Forbes also made a request to use the \$76,000 from the building reserve board designated funds to pay for the following facility upgrades:
 - HVAC system software upgrade and wiring repairs
 - Front courtyard landscaping
 - o Gymnasium bleacher repair
 - Echo reduction panels in gymnasium

Agenda Topic 4

Staff Retention and Recruitment

- Ms. Gadsden provided the following staffing update:
 - o PAVE Extended an offer to 78% of current staff. 94% of offer extended were signed.
 - New teachers applications significantly increased from 59 last year to 536 applications this year. We attribute that to increased marketing and our teacher ambassador program.
 - PAVE has filled 4 out of the 13 open roles (including two overhires).

Agenda Topic 5

Summer School Update

- Summer school will be hosted at PAVE this summer. It will be funded by the Bloomberg Summer Boost grant.
- We have hired 13 teachers (one for each grade level and special education teachers).
- We expect to enroll 135 students based on academic need.
- Family orientation will be held on May 18, 2023.
