#### Agenda Topic 1:

##### State Test Data

Ms. Gadsden shared PAVE NYSE State Test Scores listed below. She expressed that although the PAVE leadership team was disappointed by the NYST result, they were not surprised.

NYSE Results Percentage Proficient:

- 3rd Grade: ELA: 26% Math: 24%
- 4th Grade: ELA: 28% Math: 40%
- 5th Grade: ELA: 16% Math: 11%
- 6th Grade: ELA: 48% Math: 11%
- 7th Grade: ELA: 27% Math: 8%
- 8th Grade: ELA: 59% Math: 59%

Ms. Gadsden confirmed that this data reconfirms that the schools plan to add additional SPED teachers and a tutoring program in Grades 3rd - 8th was the right decision this school year.

#### Agenda Topic 2:

##### BOY Updates

The Elementary School Principals shared their excitement for the start of the school year. The both expressed a feeling of clarity that grounds their work for the school year. Principals shared that they are both more confident this year in the staff members that they have and the staff culture that they are building.
