



What information can be requested through the Freedom of Information Law (FOIL)?

Unless an exception applies, the public must be provided with access to PAVE's records which includes but is not limited to:

- Reports
- Statements
- Examinations
- Memoranda
- Opinions
- Folders
- Files
- Books
- Manuals
- Pamphlets
- Forms
- Papers
- Designs
- Drawings
- Maps
- Photos
- Letters
- Rules
- Regulations
- Codes and Policies
- Student Health Records*
- Student Immunization Records*
- Student Medical Records*
- Student Accident Reports*
- Roster containing the name of each officer and employee, his or her public office address (school address), title and salary.
- Record of the final vote of each trustee in each instance when school trustees vote (which should already be the minutes of board meetings being kept pursuant to the Open Meetings Law and charter monitoring plan).
- Safety Records
- School Safety Plan
- Reports of Fire Department Inspections
- School Contracts
- Management Contract Records
- Outside Contract Records
- SPED Contractor Records*
- Personnel Files*
- Fingerprint Clearance Records*
- Certification Records*

* All categories marked with an asterisk may contain personal and confidential or other information that should not be released pursuant to FOIL, the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act or the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (which are exceptions to FOIL).
